

INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND PREQUALIFY ("IAEP")

Metro Pacific Dumaguete Water Services, Inc. now invites interested bidders to apply for eligibility and prequalify for the bidding of the herein described project, as follows:

Name of Project : Map Digitization and Procurement of GIS (Geographic Information System) Software

Location : Dumaguete City

Brief Description: The project includes supply of software/hardware/services related to establishing a

digitized map in Dumaguete City including at least 500 meters offset to the adjacent

municipality and in establishing a GIS Application Software & GIS Tool.

Contract Duration: 6 months

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures.

Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project within five (5) years prior to the date of submission and receipt of bids.
